## Volunteer at Cave Creek Canyon, SE Arizona, in the Chiricahua Mountains





Job: hosting the Visitor Information Center, 9 AM - 3 PM, 3 days per week.

Minimum commitment is 1 month, preferably 2-3 months.

Requirements: friendly, birding or nature knowledge desired but not mandatory, prior hosting or volunteer work helpful but not required.

Work involves greeting the public, answering questions, giving directions, cleaning, and selling a few items (book, t-shirts and hats).

Three RV pads available (1 under trees) with full hook-ups and WiFi. Propane provided. One pad site is for smaller units. The other two take units up to 33-35' long, 13' high and 13' maximum slide-out width.

This area is considered one of the most diverse ecosystems in the United States, covering almost all of the life zones. It is just outside the town of Portal and starts at ~5000', rising to over 9000'. It is far enough south that snow is rare and usually melts away the same day.

Cave Creek Canyon is a quiet and spectacularly beautiful area.
